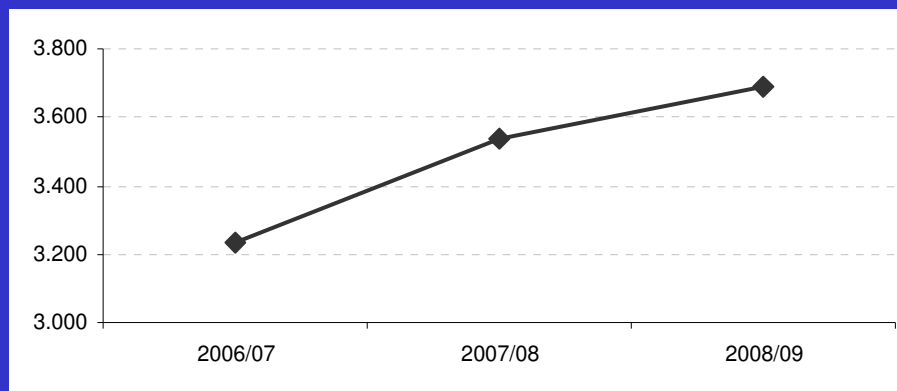

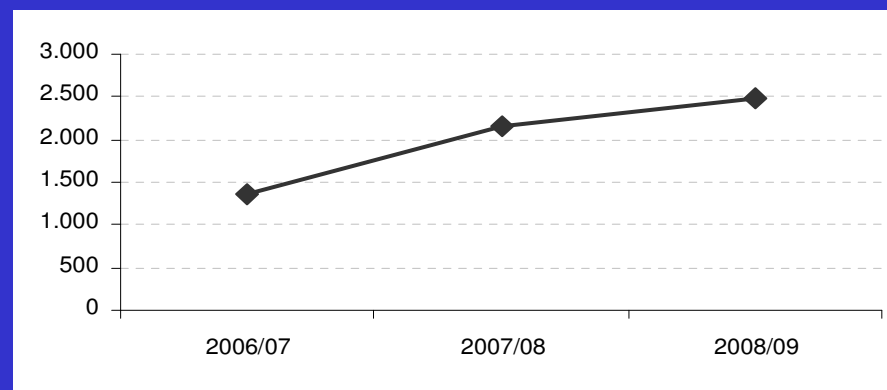

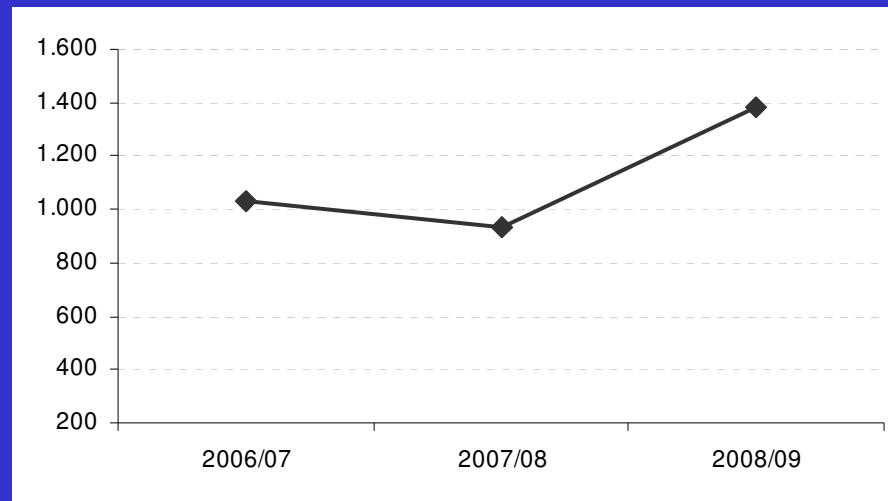

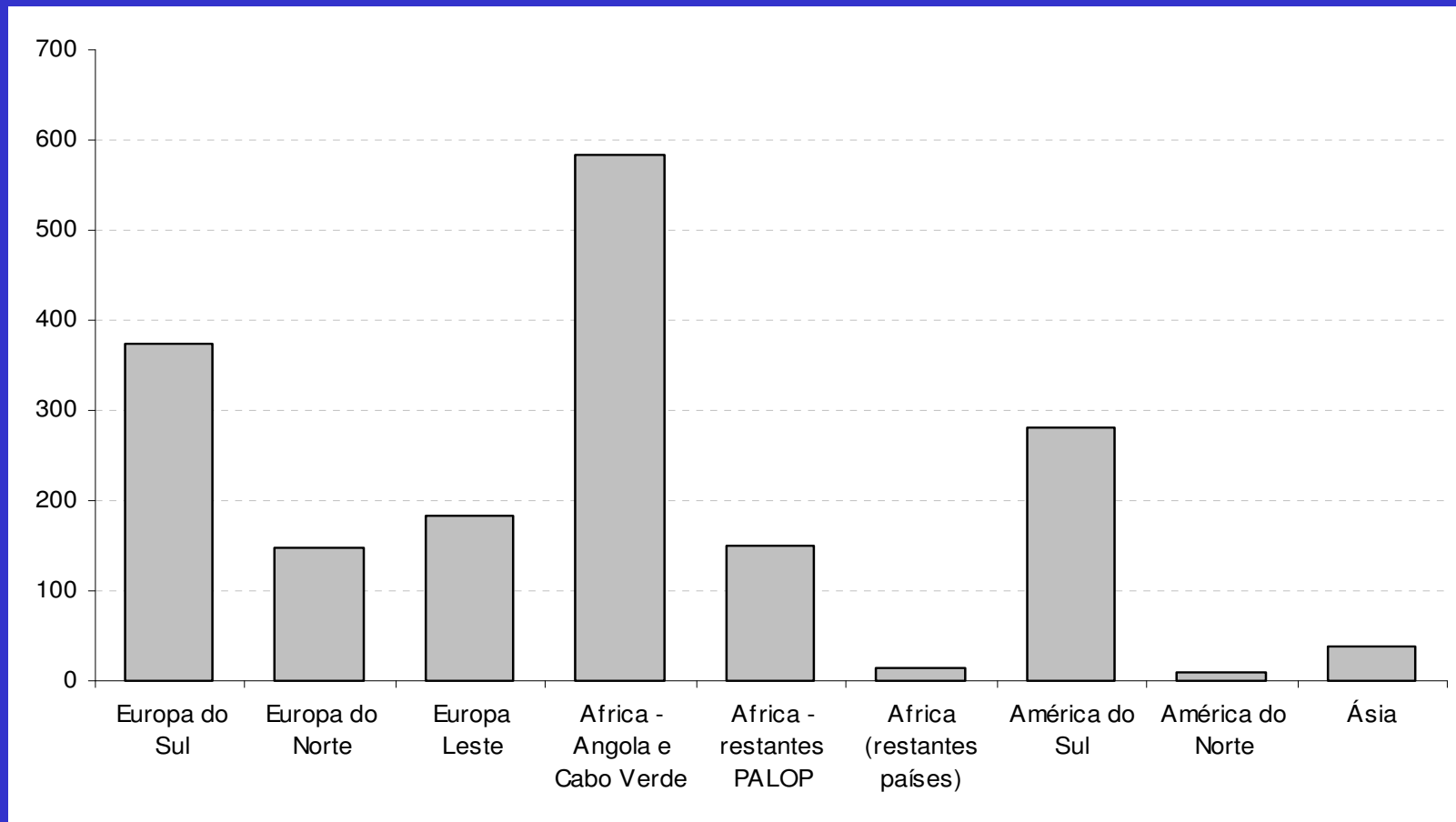

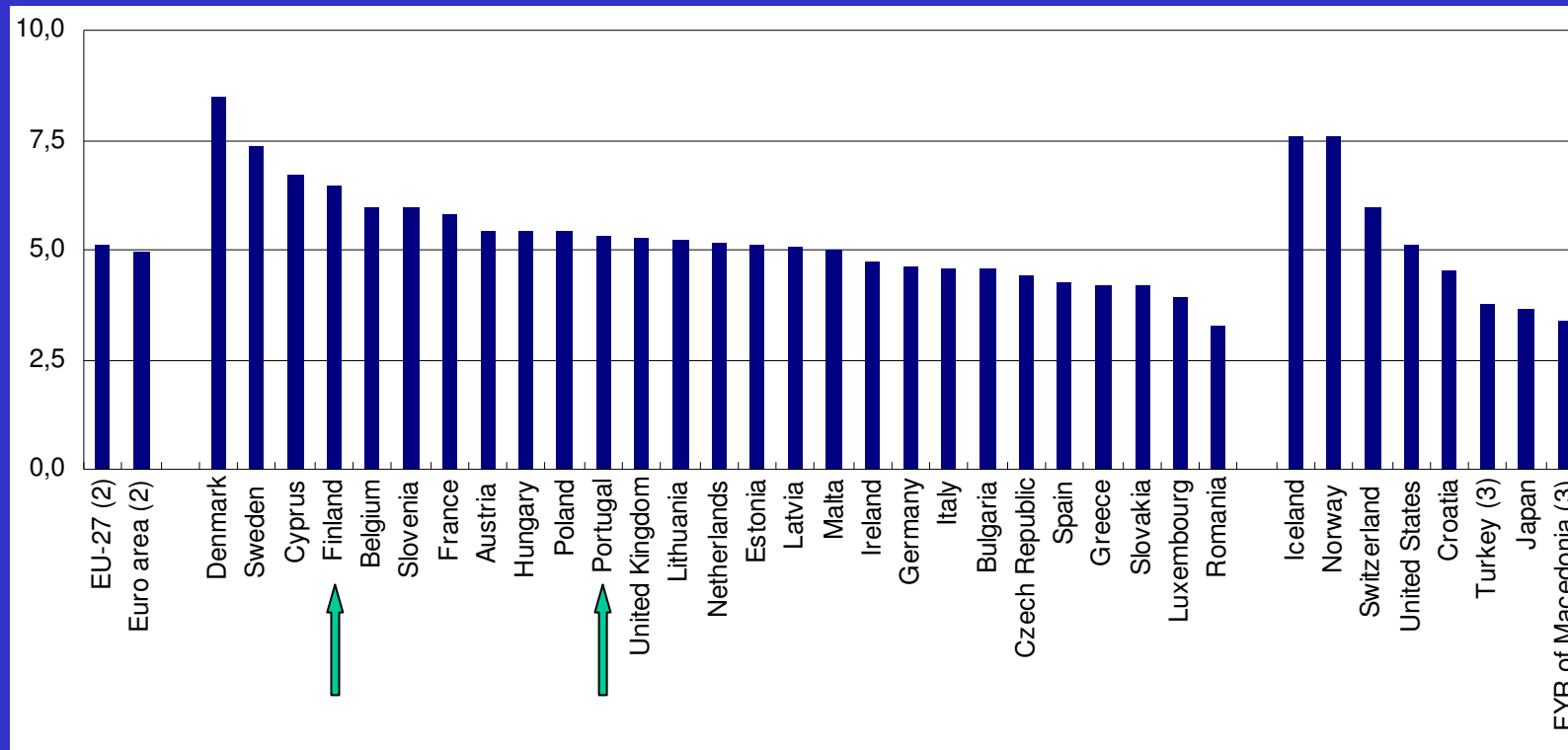


Foreign students at UTL, in 2008/09, by geographic origin



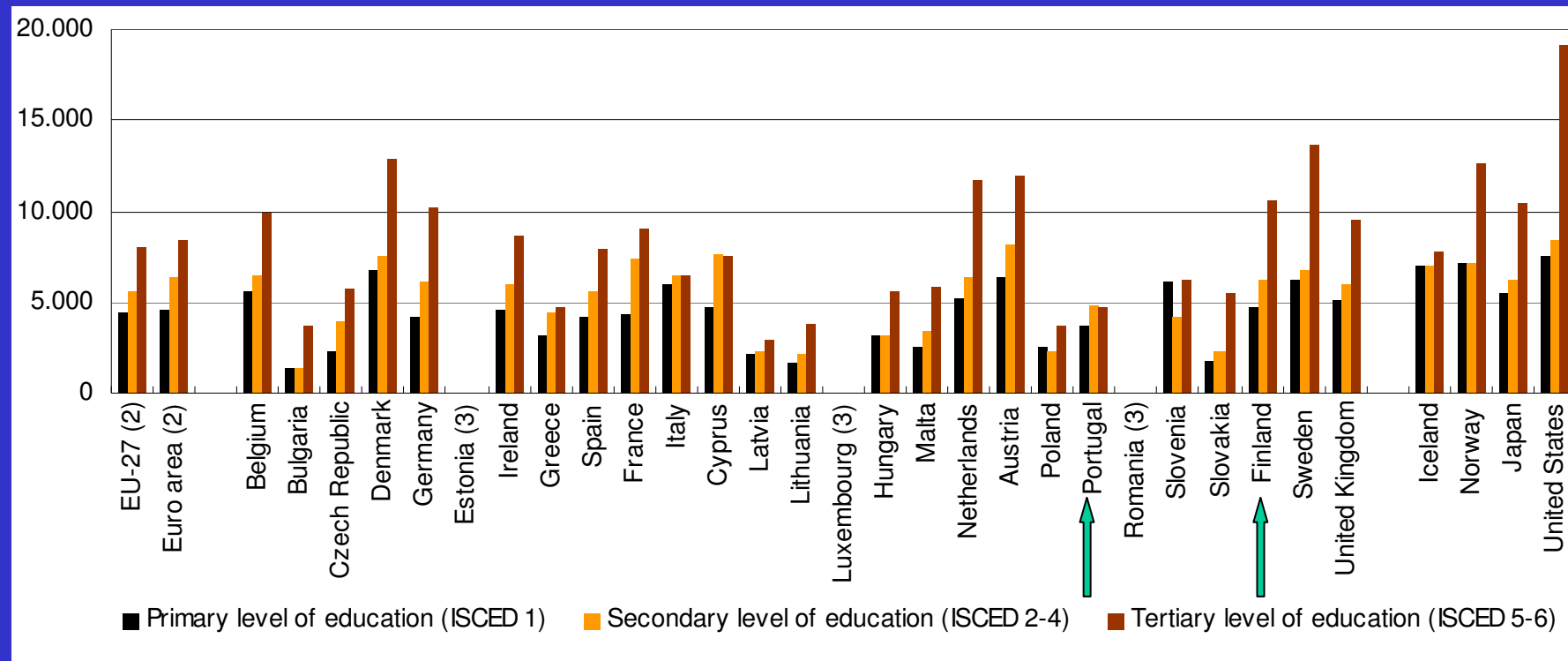


Public expenditure in Education as a Percentage of the GIP
